The Next Meeting: Our next regular meeting will be Tuesday, December 18, 2018 at the Cincinnati Air Conditioning Company, 2080 Northwest Drive, Cincinnati, Ohio. We start the meeting at 19:30 hours.

November meeting recap: There were twenty three members at the November meeting. No applications for membership were received. The Treasurer gave his report as of November 19, 2018. The checking balance is \$448.03 and total funds on hand are \$10,226.53. There was no income for the month. Expenses were \$60.00 to Microbiz for website support. No bills were presented at the meeting for payment. The Treasurers Report was approved.
